Fiction and Nonfiction

A fiction book tells a story of people, places, or things that are all made-up or imaginary. All fiction books are found together in the same section of the library. They have a letter "F" on their spines and are arranged alphabetically according to the first two letters of the author's last name.

Nonfiction books, however, usually contain information about different subjects, such as science or history. These books describe true facts and events about a topic. There are many kinds of nonfiction books. Like the fiction books, all nonfiction books are found together in the same section of the library. These books are arranged numerically according to the subject matter.

Compare these two titles—*Learning About Insects* and *Attack of the Toothless Beaver*. *Learning About Insects* describes facts about insects, so it is a nonfiction book. *Attack of the Toothless Beaver* is a made-up story, so it is fiction.
